On the afternoon of April 6, 2021, the school district was notified that a person in our **high school community** has been diagnosed with COVID-19. We began the contact tracing process immediately. We are working closely with our local and state health authority to respond to this news and protect the health of our community.

District staff have done an outstanding job following the COVID-19 Blue Print which has resulted in minimal number of students from being exposed.

Those who were determined to be a direct contact with the person who has tested positive for COVID-19 were contacted by someone from our local health authority on April 6, 2021. The local health officials have advised the school district on quarantining and testing.

Students who were NOT contacted by our local OHA will attend school as usual on April 7<sup>th</sup>.
