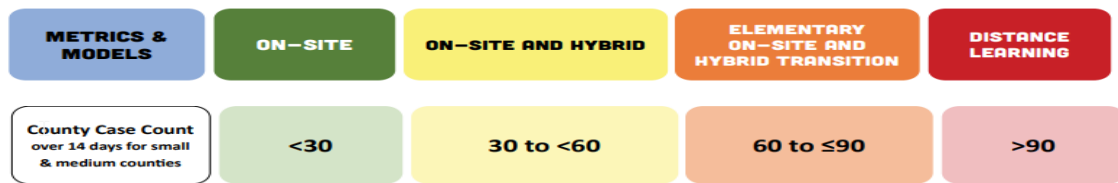


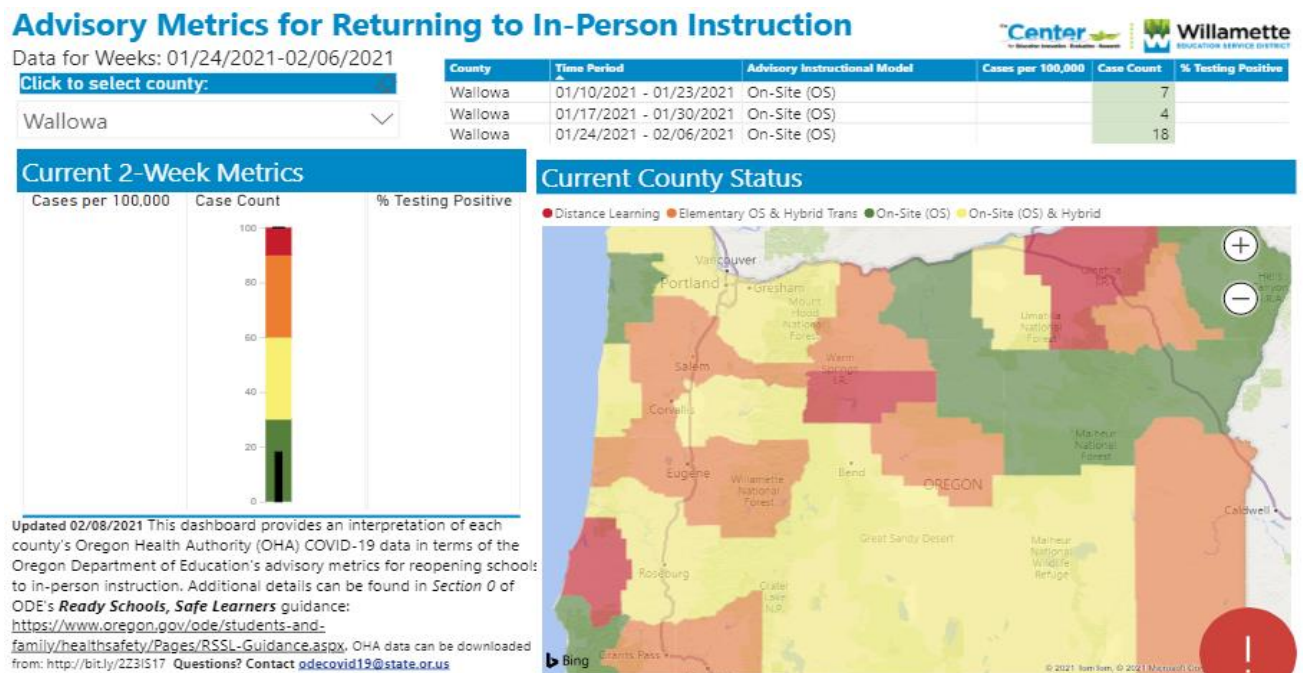

Good Day Outlaw Families,

I wanted to take a moment to touch base and remind you how our county schools are able to stay open with the onsite learning model. Currently, I am pleased to report that we are not at risk of having to shut down the school district. In addition, we have 18 COVID-19 cases this last week of 1/24/2021 and 4 COVID-19 cases the previous week bringing our county's total count as of today to 22 COVID-19 cases in a two week period. The chart below shows you how many cases we would need to have to change our educational mode of education for all students.

This data is collected on a week to week basis and is updated on Monday's.
