

Enterprise School District Campus Security Committee Meeting Minutes

Radios

Chris Skelzikty provided insight and guidance on various radio systems the district can purchase to increase campus security as well as system operations of the district. He has worked with local agencies of Enterprise with their radio systems. He informed the committee we can use loaned radios over the summer to determine which model will work best for the district. He also advised us to get our own FCC channel and will assist with submitting the paper work needed to get this done. The summer custodial crew will utilize the radios to determine which radios have the best reception throughout the district. The district will access the city public works channel this summer for this trial run. An ear piece will be provided for the custodial staff to wear during the work day as loud noises (BioMass/Boiler room) will not allow the employee to hear the radio without the ear piece. Employee training will be included as part of the implementation plan of the radios. Reiterating the importance of professionalism on the radios is essential.

DOGS- Dad's of Great Students

Chris Harris provided an update to the team letting the team know that there are three confirmed dads committed. Jered Bedard, Chris Pathoud and Chris Harris. Mandy Decker will send additional names to Chris to reach out to for the DOGS program. There will be a pizza meet and greet for the DOGS program mid-August.
