Greetings Outlaw Families,

I am extremely pleased to share with you that our upcoming 2021-2022 school year students and staff will return back to school with normalcy. On July 6th during the regular scheduled Board meeting the School Board of Enterprise received a report from Superintendent Pinkerton outlining the Oregon Department of Education's guidance which allows local control to school districts as to how the district responds to COVID-19. This allowed Superintendent Pinkerton to make a recommendation to the Board that masking and social distancing are not required. The Board agreed by voting unanimously to support the Superintendent's recommendation. All students will attend school onsite next year with the first day of school being August 30, 2021.

The district is required to submit a plan to ODE if there were to be an outbreak of COVID-19 based upon the RSSL (Ready Schools, Safe Learners) guidance. It is required to submit this plan to the Oregon Department of Education. This will then allow the district to open our doors this fall. Once this plan is submitted to ODE it will be posted on the district's webpage (www.enterpriseschool.org) for all to review.

All of the staff of Enterprise School District are extremely grateful for the grace that was demonstrated by our community during this extremely stressful time. It takes a team to take on pandemic and we did it!
