	<p>Develop an emergency preparedness plan designed to address all known threats, including natural disasters, threats from within, and threats from without. Practice the prescribed emergency response drills on a regular basis, beginning with the reunification routine. Establish an incident command system. Assign staff to periodically review and update the plan. Take care to consider the safety of special needs students in your plan. The plan should include the distribution of classroom emergency evacuation kits containing items such as a first aid kit, walkie-talkies, radio, food bars, drinking water, emergency blankets, flashlights, light sticks, wet wipes, etc.. 	<p>Install security cameras all around your campus. Make sure that they are night-vision capable and feature clarity at a distance, preferably with zoom capability. Post them at all sensitive areas in out-of-reach locations designed to minimize the risk of vandalism. 	<p>Inspect, maintain and when necessary, improve outdoor and indoor lighting, the exterior building envelope, and landscaping. Light is the best anesthetic. Anything you can do to eliminate potential hiding places, safeguard against illicit entry, and eliminate the risks associated with surreptitious movement across your campus will help to improve school security.</p>	Moderate	Staff Assessed	Enterprise School District - Main School Bldg
	<p>Add security cameras, intercom and auto-locking doors to the ES entryway vestibule so that office staff can monitor and control access to the building. Remodel office access to vestibule to improve communication and sightlines. May want to install an office counter there.</p>	Moderate	Staff Assessed	Enterprise School District - Primary School
	<p>Expand HS entryway vestibule so that inside doors are located on the opposite side of the office entry door. Add security cameras, auto-locking doors and intercom so that the office staff can monitor and control access to the building. 	<p>Consider installing reflective film at locations where school windows allow unfettered sightlines from outside the building to staff and/or students. 	<p>Install security fencing around perimeter of school to maintain safe passage between campus buildings.
