February 26, 2021

Greetings,

On the evening of February 24, 2021, the school district was notified that a person in our school community has been diagnosed with COVID-19. We began the contact tracing process immediately. We are working closely with our local and state health authority to respond to this news and protect the health of our community.

February 25th the school district was closed based upon the direction we received the previous evening. In addition, students and staff from our elementary, junior high and high school who were determined to be a direct contact with the person who has tested positive for COVID-19 were contacted by someone from our local health authority on the 25th. The local health officials have advised the school district on quarantining and testing.

Elementary School Updates

The following classrooms will return for onsite learning on Monday, March 1st with no changes to their schedule. There has not been any direct contact with the school community member who has COVID-19.

Students who were not contacted by our local OHA will attend school as usual on Monday, March 1st. These students will receive their instruction with their peers in a "one room school house format". This

temporary cohort will meet in Mrs. Fischer's classroom. Mrs. Otten and an instructional assistant will be assigned to this classroom to assist with providing quality differentiated instruction.

The following classrooms had direct contact with the school community member who has COVID-19 therefore will be required to quarantine for fourteen days from the day the class was exposed (That is why you see a variance in dates that classes may return to school). ***These classes will transition to online learning on Tuesday, March 2nd.***
